The Stober family continues the creative and social tradition of the historic estate, always committed to the common good. The father of German mobility, August Borsig, was Europe's most famous manufacturer of railways and locomotives. The entrepreneur's friendship with Humboldt and Lenné was based on their shared love for nature and gave the impetus to found Europe's first in-house corporate social system. The architects of the Borsigs were the best of their times. The last Borsig who resides at the Landgut was a member of the Kreisau Circle – the largest resistance group against the Nazis.

Together they offer a total of 105 double rooms and 23 suites, situated at the bank of the Lake Groß Behnitz at the edge of the Westhavelland nature park. The perfect place for rest and relaxation. Sustainable thanks to wood-fired heating, in-house electricity production, electro smog-reduced rooms, a rainwater toilet flush system, organic beds and textiles. Sleep in the lap of luxury in our COCO-MAT beds made of natural materials.

This is the perfect setting for successful events. 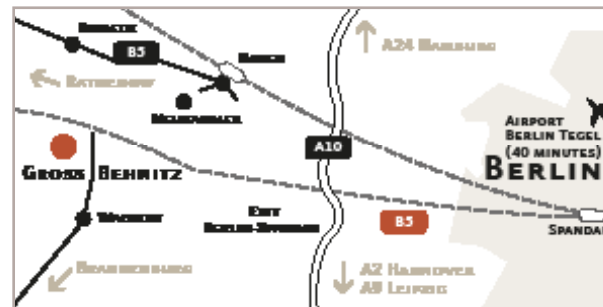

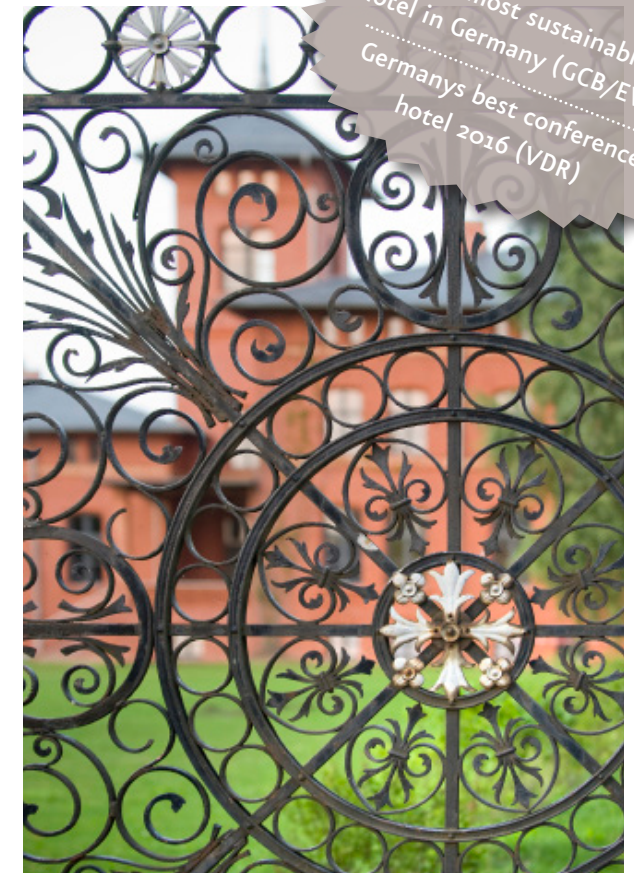

Castle

A castle once stood on this spot. Causeless demolished in 1948

Guest house

A smaller version of the castle, formerly a guest house and now a hotel with 23 double rooms and three suites

Granary

On the ground floor, where agricultural products were once traded. At the first floor you'll find the Ruth, Margret, Anneliese and Lilli salons and on the second floor the Creativity Gallery

stork

Stillhouse

Centre for historic craftsmanship including an old Borsig steam engine; "Landgut Stober and the Kreisau circle" exhibition; wine bar with indoor seating for 80 people and further 120 seats on the terrace, room Panorama

Poultry house & calf shed

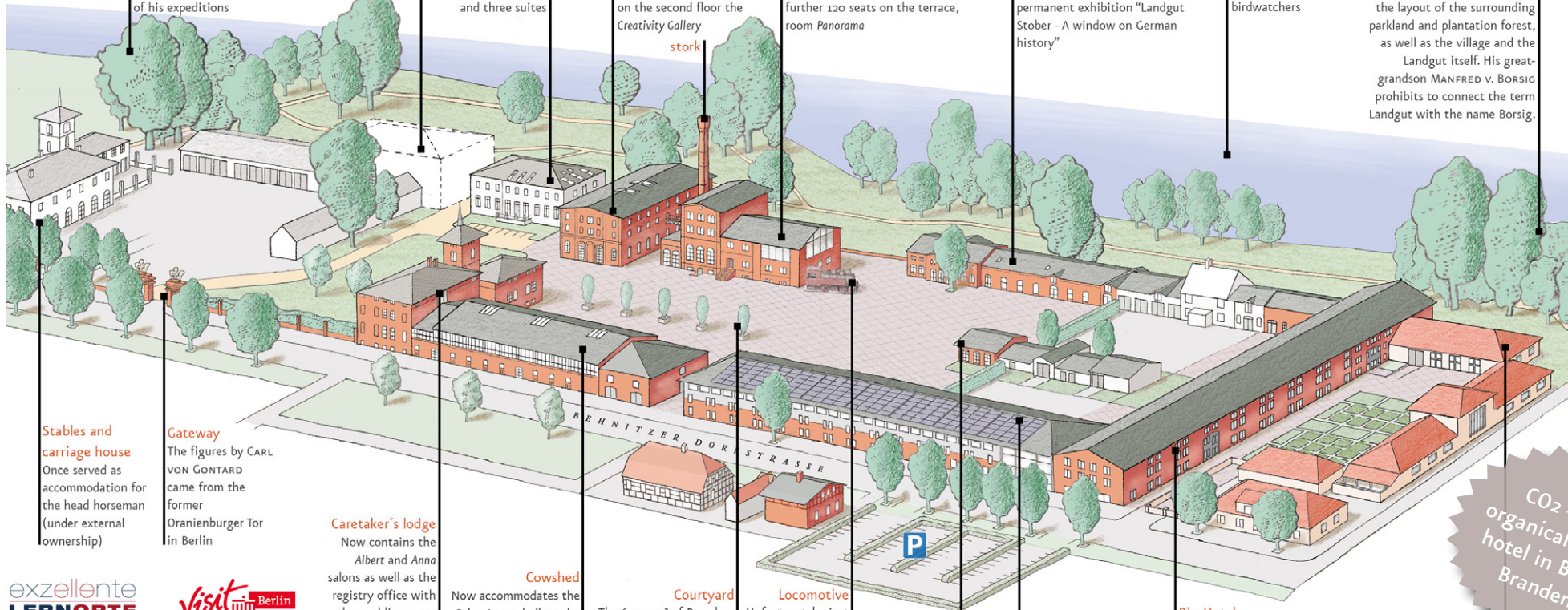
Now the Restaurant Seeterrassen with indoor seating for 80 and outdoor seating for 120 on the terrace, as well as Salon Luise for meetings or celebrations; permanent exhibition "Landgut Stober - A window on German history"

Behnitzer See

Lake with a varied stock of fish; borders the Westhavelland nature park, a paradise for birdwatchers

Park

AUGUST BORSIG was an early member of the horticultural society known as the Deutsche Gartenbau Gesellschaft 1822 e.V. His son permanently redesigned the layout of the surrounding parkland and plantation forest, as well as the village and the Landgut itself. His great-grandson MANFRED V. BORSIG prohibits to connect the term Landgut with the name Borsig.



Stables and carriage house

Once served as accommodation for the head horseman (under external ownership)

Gateway

The figures by CARL VON GONTARD came from the former Oranienburger Tor in Berlin

Caretaker's lodge

Now contains the Albert and Anna salons as well as the registry office with the wedding room and two waiting rooms, on the right for the gentlemen and on the left for the ladies

Cowshed

Now accommodates the Salon August hall on the ground floor and the Ernst, Arnold and Conrad salons for meetings or private celebrations on the first floor

Courtyard

The 6000 m² of Brandenburg cobble stones now provides space for trade shows, exhibitions and celebrations for up to 3000 people

Locomotive

Unfortunately just a KRUPP industrial locomotive (we are still on the hunt for a BORSIG locomotive)

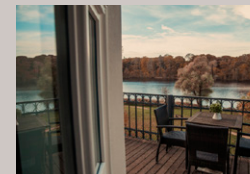
